THE SURVEY IS DESIGNED TO ASSESS THE:

- Awareness and understanding of heart valve disease
- Level of concern of heart valve health
- Frequency of stethoscope testing

HEART VALVE DISEASE AWARENESS

Over 60s are most familiar with heart attacks (59%), angina (42%) and coronary heart disease (38%) with only 7% familiar with heart valve disease (HVD)1

Only 6% of over 60s know what aortic stenosis is,1 the most common form of heart valve disease²


